

MCEM Participation

The MCEM utilizes quarterly OEM ECC drills to improve our Resource Management Process (RMP). Each quarterly drill focuses on an aspect of the RMP, and are always open to partner participation. These exercises are opportunities to:

- Test components of the County RMP (*identified as an MCEM priority in the Fiscal Year 2019 Training & Exercise Plan*)
- Train County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) staff on the RMP,
- Provide county-wide partners an opportunity to become familiar with the RMP, including:
 - Resource Request Form
 - Resource Tracking Process
 - Financial/Logistical Expectations
 - Notification Expectations (*requestor & EOC*)
 - Demobilization Efforts

Past Drills

Recently, the MCEM hosted *OpsCenter October 2018* that focused on clarifying the logistical and financial responsibilities of resource requests sent to the Multnomah County Emergency Operations Center (EOC). *Note: Readers are encouraged to review the Exercise [After-Action Report](#).*
