- [AmeriCorpsVISTA: Disaster Preparedness Planning](#), Portland, OR. The VISTA will work to mitigate the impacts of emergency disruption and maximize our ability to continue service to members and clients by building the capacity of the emergency management and service continuity programs. This position is focused on developing additional plans to support our emergency response and support member needs in the event of an emergency. **Closes May 30.**
- [AmeriCorpsVISTA: Disaster Preparedness Data and Analytics](#), Portland, OR. This position will focus on developing tools and training to support our emergency response system and ensure CareOregon members are able to access our resources in the event of a disaster. **Closes May 30.**

This leadership role will focus on strategic planning, organizational development, diversity, equity and inclusion and efficient, state-of-the-art agency operations.
