- [Emergency Preparedness Associate \(AmeriCorps\)](#), Mercy Corps. As a VISTA member at Mercy Corps you will help end poverty by building the capacity of low-income members of community organizations to prepare for emergencies. Major functions will include the design, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of community preparedness outreach programs, as well as communicating preparedness messages, and assisting in the development of an economic recovery emergency response plan.
