

Portland Area Capabilities Exercise (PACE) After-Action Report & Improvement Plan

The Portland Metropolitan Area participated in the PACE 2019 full-scale exercise April 30 - May 2, 2019. This exercise tested response capabilities to a biological agent (plague) incident affecting the region. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) developed a [regional After-Action Report](#) and [Improvement Plan](#) focusing on the exercise objectives regarding the distribution of prophylaxis medication to the public.

Multnomah County organizations identified additional exercise objectives regarding incident management and Emergency Operations Center (EOC) functions, and have developed a county-specific AAR-IP focusing on that content. This AAR-IP includes exercise observations from CareOregon, the City of Portland, the City of Gresham, and the Multnomah County Government. This document can be found [here](#).
