

Emergency Management Job Openings

- [Regional Emergency & Disaster Healthcare Coalition Training & Exercise Coordinator](#), Spokane, WA. This position will serve to meet the training and exercise needs of the REDi HCC, serving the 19 counties and 4 tribal nations of eastern Washington. This position will be responsible for the development and implementation of the training and exercise program for the HCC. This position will be involved in the coordination and planning efforts to support REDi HCC response including development, implementation and coordination of plans and standard operating procedures for an effective health care system response to any incident or event impacting the region. **Closes September 6th.**
- [Public Information Officer](#), Bureau of Development Services, City of Portland. The PIO will assist the Communications Manager and team to support the strategic communications needs of the 425-person organization; manage the bureau's response to media inquiries; identify, develop, and execute proactive and strategic media and outreach opportunities for bureau efforts; write, edit and prepare content for a variety of print and online informational outlets; manage all aspects of the bureau's social media program; and serve on the City's and bureau's PIO and emergency response teams, among other duties. **Closes September 9th.**

Assist with the administration and coordination of fiscal and grant processes for disaster recovery and hazard mitigation for the State of Oregon. Oversees the distribution of disaster payments required for Presidential Disaster Declarations, maintaining reports and files in an effort to sustain robust audit support. Evaluates processes and procedures to ensure that the agency is utilizing the most effective and efficient methods available, and suggests alternatives or improvements when deficiencies are noted. **Closes September 12th.**
