Course Description:

Hosted by Oregon Office of Emergency Management (OEM) and FEMA Region X, this virtual, two-day course is an intermediate-level training designed to describe the core principles and processes of HSEEP, its standardized methodology, available resources, and practical skill development, which will assist in developing an HSEEP consistent exercise program.

Course Objective:

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to understand the role of HSEEP in National Preparedness, and how HSEEP exercise principles and methodology support efforts across the whole community to improve our national capacity to build, sustain, and deliver core capabilities.

Target Audience:

The target audience for this training are those involved in planning, program management, design and development, conduct, evaluation, and improvement planning of HSEEP consistent exercises.
