COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This combined course provides participants with an overview of communication needs and strategies for Public Information Officers (PIOs) before, during, and after an emergency. Over the three days, participants will define the role of PIOs within the Incident Command System (ICS), learn the benefits and challenges of working with multiple PIOs in joint information systems, study and apply effective news release writing and interview guidance, and identify strategies for building partnerships at all levels. This course is a mix of lecture and hands-on learning, providing a well-rounded educational experience.
