

4. Development and Maintenance

4.1 Training & Exercise Schedule

This Damage Assessment Plan requires an active Training and Exercise Program (TEP) that engages key partners with defined responsibilities and approaches plan implementation through a continuous improvement lens. The Damage Assessment Plan-related training and exercise program is developed in coordination with the MCEM Training and Exercise Specialist.

The Damage Assessment Management Plan TEP will include the components listed in Table 4 following any initial development or version update. This TEP will be included in the MCEM Integrated Preparedness Plan (IPP) to influence organizational priorities.
