Helen Bramnick was born in Antwerp, Belgium in 1935 to Polish born parents. Her family had a harrowing journey during the war through France, Spain, Portugal, and Cuba, where they spent several years. The family finally made it to the Lower East side of Manhattan in 1946, when Helen was 11 years old. She attended public schools in New York City, where she learned English and the American way of life. She was married to her husband, Stanley, a conservative Rabbi for 60 years, and they had two children. Helen has lived in Boca Raton since 2015 and is active in local Holocaust education programs.
