The Michigan State University Institute of Water Research is recruiting up to 10 farms in the lower peninsula of Michigan to participate in on-farm research investigating water and nutrient use efficiency

BENEFITS TO COOPERATORS

Free, real-time access to precipitation and soil moisture data from monitoring stations in each participating field.

Timeline

Monitoring stations will be installed Fall 2025 and monitor through Fall 2028 (3 growing seasons)

Who can participate?

Qualifying fields can include any of the following

- Irrigated or non-irrigated
- Row crops
- Vegetable crops

Preferred: field with long term lease or owned
