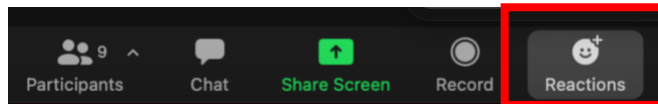

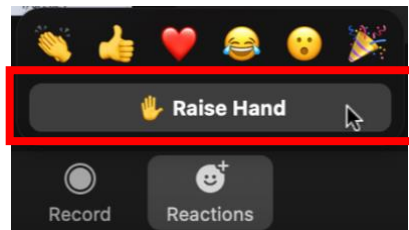

Raise your hand option

- At the bottom of your zoom screen there is the Reactions button



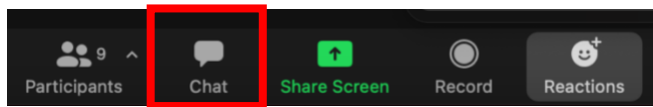
- Press that button and there will be a pop up that has options.



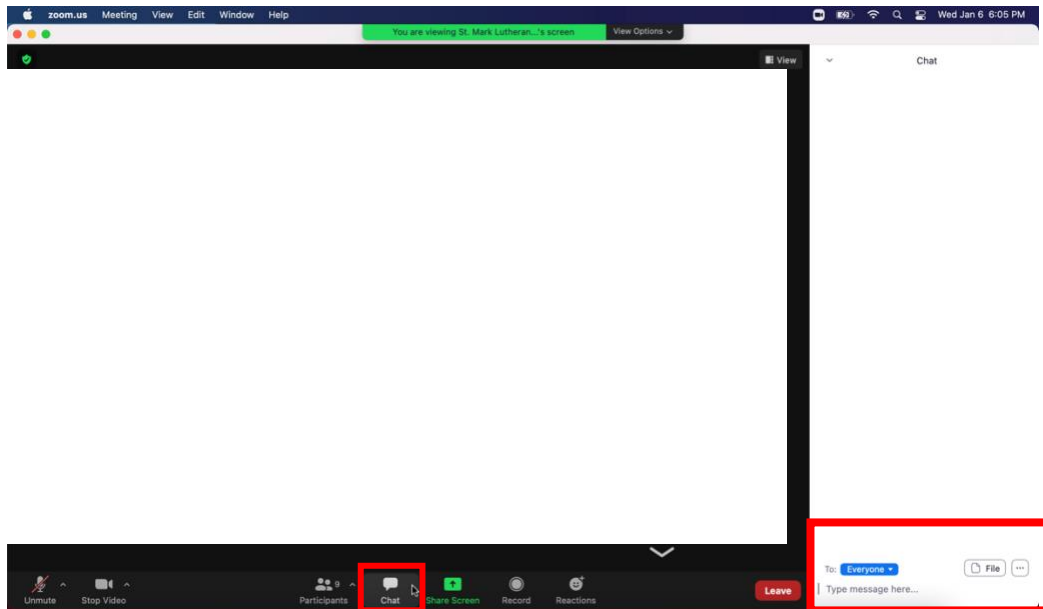
- Press the Raise Hand button and a little icon will appear in the upper left hand corner of your picture. There will be a few people that will be watching for these and will write your name down if we are in the middle of answering/explaining something else. And then call on you to unmute yourself to ask your question.

Put your question in the chat option

- At the bottom of your zoom screen there is a Chat button



- Press that button and a chat window will pop up on the side and you will be able to type your question in. You can either send this to everyone or someone specific.
