



The Vestry aims to complete and approve a 2022 operating budget in December. The following points pertain to the current year's budget and may help you appreciate the value of your financial support.

- Box of 1000 wheat Communion wafers—\$15.99
- One professional singer for a Mass—\$90.00
- Annual financial audit—\$14,500
- Pantry annual budget—\$42,500
- Diocese of Chicago pledge/support—\$61,000
 - All personnel salaries, stipends, benefits-\$450,000

Some 2022 Considerations

- The Vestry has provided funding for the full-time Curate position through August 2022.
- Inflationary pressure on the cost of food will impact pantry@ascension.
- Increased expenses for sustaining and improving our new technology.
