Music and Theatre Scholarship Opportunities for Graduating Stevenson Students

Rebecca Gayle Berger Memorial Music Fund Scholarship (Appendix D)

A scholarship in memory of Rebecca Gayle Berger's passing in 2000, a Stevenson sophomore who was passionate about music, theatre, and giving back to her community. She was a charter member of Syncopation and inducted into the International Thespian Society. This scholarship was established in her memory by her parents and older brother. The scholarship will be awarded to two (2) seniors who exemplify similar passion within their community and are planning on majoring in Music or Theatre.

The Geri Getlin Foundation Scholarship

Twenty-one years ago Geri Getlin lost her battle with cancer. Geri's passion was the theater and performing arts. In an effort to share Geri's passion with others, the Geri Getlin Foundation was formed. Geri utilized the performing arts to fund projects she believed in. In 1982, she helped District 96 purchase new computers using the proceeds for her first children's performance, which she both wrote and directed. She followed that up with a second performance in 1985 also to benefit the school district. She later went on to help start the Buffalo Grove Community Theater program by writing and directing four theater productions for the community. It was the success of these productions that laid the foundation for the fine arts program found in the community today.

The Lisa Klitzky Foundation Scholarship

This scholarship is in memory of Lisa Klitzky, a 1995 Stevenson alumni and artist. Friends like Lisa come along but once in a lifetime. She was one of a kind. She had a warm heart and an unmatched kindness toward others. Lisa passed away at the age of 25 after enduring an 18-month battle with a rare form of pediatric cancer called Rhabdomyosarcoma. The Lisa Klitzky Foundation was formed ensuring that her spirit and legacy of beauty, art, and kindness to others lives on. Lisa's loving spirit allows this foundation to make a difference in the lives of others, as she would have done herself. The Foundation supports adolescent cancer survivors facing long-term physical and psychological challenges in their post-treatment years at the University of Chicago's Comer Children's Hospital's Cancer Survivor Center.
