Scholarship Descriptions

SCTA Book Award - \$500 (Up to 10 awarded)

Scholarships to help students with the cost of books and materials.

Minimum GPA 2.0

SCTA Scholarship - \$2,000 (Up to 4 awarded) Based on academic excellence leadership and community service. **Minimum GPA 3.0**

SCTA Most Improved Scholarship - \$2,000 (Up to 4 awarded) SCTA Most Improved Scholarship awarded to a student who has demonstrated significant academic improvement over the course of their high school career. **Minimum GPA 2.5**

Frank Tofell Memorial Scholarship - \$2,500

Scholarship awarded to a high school student who has demonstrated most improved academic achievement. **Minimum GPA 2.8**

Bob Priestley Memorial Scholarship - \$750
