



# Washington State Dental Laboratory Association

All dental labs servicing dentists in the State of Washington must:

Register with the Department of Health

Disclose to the dentist materials used in the device

Disclose to the dentist the city, state and country where the device was made

In addition, effective January 31, 2021:

The owner or an employee must complete 12-hours of NBC-approved continuing education annually

The owner or CDT must work a minimum of 30 hours a week, on site, in which the registration number is issued.

The Registration number has to be on all forms of communication between the dentist and the Lab. For example; Rx forms, invoices, and statements.

Finally, by January 31, 2025:

The owner or an employee must be a Certified Dental Technician in good standing with the National Board for Certification

The following nonrefundable fees will be charged:
