2017 County Allocation Tracker (CAT) & Funding Updates

CAT Finalization for 2017 means that all OMH funding according to the Final Issued 2017 State Aid Letter is allocated to providers and their programs via the CAT. By completing this process prior to the end of November, the final 2017 CATs become the starting point for the 2018 CATs (NYS rolls the data forward to create the new year CAT).

Accounting: Any unallocated State Aid Funding or known surpluses of funds should be moved to a deferred account for future recoveries by NYS Disabilities. This process should be done before the year end closing to ensure that any unused Deficit Funding Dollars is set aside until NYS Closeout and recovery of funds.

Value Based Payments (VBP) Seminars & Discussions

VBP Bootcamp Sessions across the 5 regions of New York State (Capital Region, New York City, North Country, Central/Western, and Long Island) have now been completed. Bootcamp Sessions are considered the “4th Semester of VBP University.” It is important to read and understand the VBP Roadmap and start to evaluate where your agency is currently and starting toward readiness.

Safety Net Payment Updates

In the last weeks of October, Safety Net Payment Calculations for the period of 4/1/2017 - 3/31/2018 were issued. Counties who did not reach the 5.00% Minimum Threshold did not receive payments, but should have still received calculation statements.
