

## **Fiscal Officer Due Date Reminders!**

May 1st: Consolidated Fiscal Report (CFR) submission for **OMH and SED** providers without a 30-day extension are due! Submission including upload, required signatures, financial statements, etc. **NYS 30-day CFR extensions (OMH, SED) are due by April 30<sup>th</sup>.**

June 1st: CFR submissions for All Disabilities (OMH, OASAS, OPWDD, & SED) are due! Submissions includes upload, required signatures, financial statements, etc.

June 15th: County approved final claims sent to NYS disabilities (OMH, OASAS, OPWDD, SED) including required signatures, required CFR schedules, OPWDD voucher form, etc.

July 1st: January - March 2019 Q1 NYMH Cost Reports (Federal Salary Sharing)

## **Children's Transition Timeline**

There are several important events that kickoff on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 related to the Children's Transition which include:

- Implementation of Family Peer Support Services as State Plan Service in managed care and fee-for-service
- BH Services already in managed care for adults 21 and older are available in managed care for individuals 18-20 (e.g. PROS, ACT, etc.)
- OMH licensed SED designated clinics serving children with SED diagnosis are carved-in to managed care
- SSI children begin receiving State Plan behavioral health services in managed care
- Three-year phase in of Level of Care (LOC) expansion begins
