Eligibility

- Compliance with *Consumers Energy Business Energy Efficiency Program Requirements*

- Program Effective Dates
 - Effective dates of the *Consumers Energy Business Energy Efficiency Programs* bonus incentives are Sept. 6, 2019 through Nov. 30, 2019. Effective Sept. 6, 2019 all new projects submitted to the *Consumer Energy Business Energy Efficiency Program* will receive bonus incentives as long as the project is completed, and final applications are received no later than Nov. 30, 2019. The Final Application must then be received by Nov. 30, 2019 and paid in 2019.
 - The new Final Application must be received by Nov. 30, 2019 and paid in 2019.
 - 2019 bonus incentives will be closed before Nov. 30, 2019 if/when the program energy savings goals are achieved, as determined within the sole discretion of Consumers Energy.
 - New Pre-Application and new Final Applications must be received on and/or after Sept. 6, 2019 and on and/or before Nov. 30, 2019 to be included in the 2019 bonus incentives payout.
