In 1859, Mother Mary Xavier Mehegan founded the community of the Sisters of Charity of Saint Elizabeth with their first motherhouse here in Newark. With a mission of service to the underserved, the Charities opened hospitals, orphanages, and schools. In 1869, they established Saint Vincent Academy (SVA) on West Market Street.

SVA's 150-year history of Catholic education for young girls is as relevant today as ever. It is focused on women modeling, mentoring and educating young girls and nurturing them for their roles as tomorrow's leaders in our communities.
