

### Long Island Spirits Hand Sanitizer Order Form



Pharmaceutical Grade 80% Alcohol Based Hand Sanitizer produced under the Guidance of the US Dept of HHS, FDA & CDER during Public Health Emergencies. By law, Vodka needs to be distilled to above 190 Proof before it is blended down. Our LiV Vodka is distilled to 192 Proof, which only a small number of distilleries have the proper rectification columns to do this. We then are taking the equivalent of a full Liter of our LiV Standard Vodka Beverage Grade Alcohol (which would retail for \$30 per Liter) prior to being blended with distilled water and producing the equivalent of 16 oz of Hand Sanitizer.
