

Seniors Stay Home, Stay Safe | Free Home Delivery for Essential Needs

<u>All Seniors Assistance Program</u> (ASAP) is a new Town service that will provide FREE delivery from participating local stores who do not have their own delivery services.

Seniors are the most vulnerable to COVID19. The CDC advises seniors to stay home to reduce the chance of COVID 19 infection. However, trips to the local markets, pharmacies or other retail stores are still necessary. To address this need and to help our seniors remain safe, the Town is providing a new FREE delivery service

Eligible. All seniors over the age of 60 within the Town, regardless of income, are eligible.

Seniors can enroll in the program online or by phone. Participating stores will be listed on the Town website. Seniors will call or email stores directly to place orders. Orders will be prepaid. Stores will notify the Town when an order is filled. The program will only provide this service Monday through Friday during regular business hours (8:30 to 4:00). Orders can be placed between 8:30 and 11:30 a.m. Deliveries will be made between 1 and 4:00 p.m. each week day. Drivers will carry an official Town identification, using an official Town vehicle and be wearing protective gloves and will deliver to resident's front door. Drivers will not enter your residence or make direct contact with you.
