Building Goals:

- Goal 1: 80% of the students at Augusta Elementary will either score at or above grade level or will show one-year's growth in the area of reading as measured by the DRA 2 assessment.
- Observation and feedback of small group reading sessions
- Invite instructional coaches as needed
- Review and share reading strategies found in *The Reading Strategies/ The Writing Strategies* books by Jennifer Serravallo.
- Build up resources in the book room.
- Tier II meeting to discuss struggling students
- Peer observations of other teachers
- Have students set goals
- Implement Growth Mindset strategies as we move through the book *Growth Mindset Playbook* by Annie Brock and Heather Hundley

Building Goals:

- Goal 2: 80% of Augusta Elementary student will attain a proficiency level of 75% or higher in the area of mathematics as measured by the quarterly benchmarks or make one year of growth as measured by STAR math.
- PD on problem solving and number talks -given by Amanda Schweissguth
- Provide feedback during math lessons
- Share instructional practices during PLC
