# How to Evangelize by “Doing Nothing”: on Cultivating the Stillness Necessary for Communion

There is the old saying: “one cannot give what one does not possess.” If we accept this as true, and if evangelization is fundamentally the invitation of one person to another to share communion with the person of God, and in and through God, the members that constitute his Church, then the first task of evangelization will always be first and foremost the task of developing a more intimate relationship with the Triune Lord.

This always necessitates attention, and attention always requires stillness, a kind of “doing nothing.” This talk will briefly treat the topic of “doing nothing” as the ground for evangelization, with a discussion of the challenges we face to the stillness we must cultivate, especially in the form of distractions and rivals for our attention.
