- Title: The title should accurately summarize the subject of the proposed presentation.
- Author(s): Provide names and an affiliation of all authors (mailing addresses, telephone, fax, e-mail). Underline the presenting author.
- Text: The single-spaced abstract should state the purpose, significant results, and main conclusions of your work. Abstracts must not exceed 250 words.
- Format: Poster, oral (20-30 minutes). Please indicate the format(s) desired.
