



The Indiana Silver Jackets Fluvial Erosion Hazard (FEH) Mitigation team is holding a series of five free workshops around the state to introduce the FEH program and to review a new manual on tools and methods developed in the most recent phase of the FEH Program. The manual outlines methods of investigation and best practices for addressing fluvial erosion in locations where avoidance is not an option.
