




1. How long have you been a SESP?


2. Which region are you located in?


3. How would you most closely identify your race?










8. Is your SESP student(s) able to access remote learning?




10. How prepared did you feel for the first IEP meeting for your student(s) this past year?

11. School districts should provide access to a student's records as soon as possible or within 10 days of the request. Typically, how long after your request does it take to receive the student's records?




12. State special education laws requires that transition services begin at the age of 14. Have you had input into filling out the transition planning form?


13. DCF begins transition planning for a student at the age of 16. Have you been in contact with your SESP student's social worker regarding the transition plan?


14. Please describe the typical communication you have had with DCF social workers once you were assigned a student. (Check all that apply)


15. If your appointment ended for any reason, did you have the opportunity to assist in the transition process to the next SESP?


16. What did you do with your student's records at the end of the appointment? (Check all that apply)






21. Which of the following training and support services have you accessed? (Check all that apply)


22. How would you rate the quality of support you received?






24. Please tell us your preference for receiving information and trainings, consider now and when this crisis is over. (Check all that apply) -




25. What days and times would work best for you to attend an event or Networking meeting?
