



Field Mission Report: Rapid Needs Assessment of Les Cayes 14 August 2021

Key Findings:

- Arrival of HaitiOne DART Team: 3:00pm. Ongoing tremors throughout the day.
- Urgent Request from Mayor for Shelter Kits and Additional Medical Support
- Coordination with DPC, Government officials and locally established partners in effect.
- Majority of homes suffered damage, with most families unwilling to enter homes or buildings under concrete roof.
- Significant damage to Bonne Finne Hospital rendering nearly inop with no power; Centre Lumiere and Immaculate Conception Hospitals still operational, but in need of vital resourcing (meds, supplies and personnel).
- Multiple collapsed hotels and many multi-story buildings, including Le Manguier Hotel (totally collapsed), Cayimit's Hotel (totally collapsed) and one other major hotel in Les Cayes.
- Estimated Families Assess Today: 95+ families
- Known Deceased: 13
- Transportation passable on major roads and bridges.

Recommended Next Steps:

- Objectives for August 15th, 2021
 - Meeting with Mayor of Les Cayes to coordinate assessment data and response
 - Assess Hospital at Camp Perrin
 - Support and Asses Church Partner Needs with Reciprocal Ministries Intl (RMI)
 - Map Logistics/Road/Bridge Obstacles and identify all UNPASSABLE routes.

Resource Requests:

- Mayor of Les Cayes: Shelter kits, food, and hygiene kits for people receiving medical care, as hospital are overrun.
- Centre de Sante:
 - *IV solution, intracatheter Antibiotic IV Ceftriaxone and Flagyl plus gentamicine. They urgently need Manitol and Dexamethasone*
- General Hospital les Cayes:
 - Personnel: orthopedist, 2 surgeons, and 2 anesthetists.
 - *IV solution, intracatheter 18 and 20 Suturea vicril cheomic and silk, Soft band Gypsona Elastic Bandages, Gauze bandages, Antibiotic IV Ceftriaxone and Flagyl, amicillin plus gentamicine. Diclofenac inj and Tramadol inj.*
- Bonne Fin
 - *2 Generators*
 - *Shelter (large tent), food, and hygiene kits.*
 - *Need fully operational field units and capacities.*

Immaculee Conception des Cayes, General Hospital	<p>100 bed capacity, fully operational with waiting lines outside (estimated 30).</p> <p>Many temporary beds set up outside under shaded coverings.</p> <p>Building in stable condition.</p> <p>[4:40 PM, 8/14/2021] Dr. Marléne Adrien: Great need for 2 additional orthopedist 2 surgeons and 2 Anesthesist</p> <p>They have received around double effectif of their capacity and are expecting more cases from the rural areas 50 cas are stable 20 more urgents are being taken care of. Few have already been evacuated</p> <p>Medical director Dr Peterson Gede 509 3720 3053 has shared his needs with us:</p> <p><i>IV solution, intracatheter 18 and 20 Suturea vicril cheomic and silk, Soft band Gypsona Elastic Bandages, Gauze bandages, Antibiotic IV Ceftriaxone and Flagyl, amicillin plus gentamicine. Diclofenac inj and Tramadol inj.</i></p> <p>BROKEN INFRASTRUCTURES SURGICAL AND EMERGENCY BUILDINGS, XRAY ROOM AND Pediatrics ward .</p> <p>3 operating are unusable</p> <p>Only one functioning outside the main building built within a container</p> <p>[4:43 PM, 8/14/2021] Dr. Marléne Adrien: Note that most patients are kept outside in the 2 health centers we already visited . People are scared and run after each aftershocks</p>
Rue Dexua 7	20 collapsed houses; 7 deceased.
Hotel Cayimit	<p>Totally collapsed.</p> <p>Unknown deceased within building.</p>
Le Manguier Hotel	<p>Totally collapsed.</p> <p>Unknown deceased within building.</p>
Rue Boilevard Quatre Chemin	15 families affected lost their homes and 5 family members deceased.



Rue Fond Frede	20 families affected lost their homes, 5 people injured very bad and been transferred to hospitals.
Bonne Fin Hospital	<p>Everyone is outside – no patients in the building. Building deemed unsafe/inop. No power! Request for 2 generators.</p> <p>Bonne fin hospital is the most affected hospital they have 18 patients that are extremely bad, that need to transfer immediately to a place they need some tents but taking those people to a different place it's an urgent need...</p>
Rue Laval	25 families lost their houses; One 8 month old baby deceased after a wall fell on her..
Rue Coquette	15 families affected lost their homes 1 hôtel collapsed
