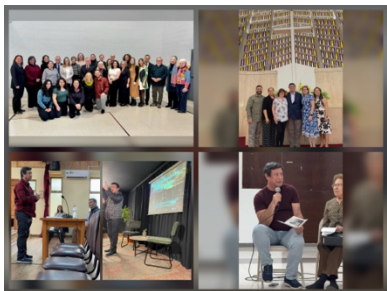


The Power of Anonymity... – December 2025

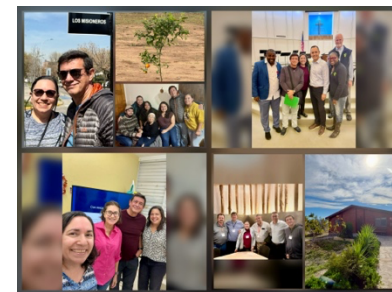
