TURTLE WATCH RESERVATIONS - We are taking reservations for this year's July Turtle Watch programs. Use this link to make your reservations, www.friendsofcanaveral.com. Programs are open to all persons eight (8) years of age and older. Reservations have a maximum of six (6) people per reservation. The fee for this program is \$25.00 per person ages 16 and above; 15 and under \$10.00. The programs will be presented in both Apollo and Playalinda Districts and run from 8:00 PM until midnight on most Friday and Saturday nights in June and July. Turtle Watch programs give park visitors a unique opportunity to see a live mother sea turtle nesting.

SUNDAY 5th- 10:00 AM- "SEASHORE 101" - Join Park staff for a 30-minute talk to discover what makes Canaveral National Seashore so special. Meet at the Visitor Center. (30 minutes)

MONDAY 13th - 10:00 AM- "THE SEA TURTLES ARE HERE"-Find out the current numbers of sea turtle nests on your national seashore. Learn about the 4 different species that use our shores to lay their eggs. Meet at the Visitor Center. (1 hour)

MONDAY 13th and 20st - 1:00 PM- "MANATEE TALK" – Observe manatee in their natural environment and learn about their unique characteristics from a park ranger. Meet at the Visitor Center in the Apollo District. (30 minutes)

MONDAY 20th - 10:00 AM - "BEACH WALK" -Discover gifts from the sea on a walk on the shore. We'll look for seashells, driftwood, and other wonderful surprises. Be sure to put on sunscreen and bring plenty of water. (1 hour)

MONDAY 27th - 10:00 AM BEACH CLEAN-UP" - Help keep our beaches clean. Join us to clean up your national park Bring water, sunscreen, bug repellent and a hat. We provide trash bags and show you how keep a record of what you collect. (1 hour)

WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY IN JULY- "JUNIOR ANGLER PROGRAM" - 10:00 AM- 12:00 PM - Canaveral National Seashore will host a free summer program. Youths aged 8 and up will learn ethical angling.
