SATURDAY 7TH – 9:00 AM “SHORELINE SEASHELL HUNT” – Search for that seashell treasure and help keep our National Parks trash free along the way. Dress to get wet. Bring water-shoes, gloves, water and sunscreen. Trash bags will be provided. Meet at parking area 9. (1 hour)

THURSDAY 12TH & 26TH -10:00 AM “KAYAKING MOSQUITO LAGOON” - Join a ranger as you explore this rich and diverse estuary of national significance. Some experience is required. You must be at least 10 years old and able to paddle. You must wear covered shoes (no sandals or flip-flops). Bring water, sunscreen and a hat. Dress to get wet. Individuals with their own kayaks or canoes are welcome call and sign up. Reservations begin: one week in advance. Call (321) 403-9334, to reserve a spot and kayak (sit on top) if needed (LIMITED KAYAK AVAILABILITY). Groups are small so reservations fill quickly. Meet at Eddy Creek. (2 -3 hours)

THURSDAY 19TH – 9:30 AM “SEA TURTLE’S & COFFEE WITH A RANGER” - Discuss with a ranger Canaveral Nat’l Seashore’s 2017 sea turtle nesting season and the seashore habitat. Bring water, sunscreen and repellent. Coffee provided or bring your own. Meet at the Eddy Creek Pavilion. (1 hour)

SATURDAY 28TH – 9:00 AM “CREEPY CRAWLY SEASHORE” – Explore the barrier island with a ranger. Discuss the various wildlife that creep and crawl along the seashore. Do a Halloween craft afterwards. Halloween costumes invited. Bring water and sunscreen. Meet at the Eddy Creek pavilion. (1 hour)
