PLEASE NOTE: all programs are subject to cancellation and/or rescheduling due to staff limitations, weather conditions or other factors. Some programs require reservations, a minimum age, or a cost-recovery fee. Call 386-428-3384 for program information during Visitor Center operating hours (9 a.m. to 5 p.m.). Entrance fees apply to all interpretive program participants. All programs meet the requirements for the Canaveral National Seashore Junior Ranger program.

SATURDAY, April 19 - “FEE-FREE DAY” -- National Park Week is happening April 19 to April 27 this year. Entrance fees will be waived on April 19, 2025, to kick off the celebration and to encourage everyone to enjoy their national parks in person.

TUESDAYS April 1 and April 29, and SATURDAY, April 19 – 9 a.m. BEACH WALK - Join a park ranger on a walk through the unique ecosystems of the seashore. Bring a hat, sunscreen, insect repellent and water. Be prepared to walk a mile on the beach. Meet at Parking Lot #2. We will leave promptly at 9 a.m. (Activity duration: 45 minutes)

SATURDAY, April 5 – 8 a.m. to noon. TRASH BASH BEACH CLEANUP - In partnership with Keep Brevard Beautiful and Canaveral National Seashore, help keep our seas trash free. Meet at Parking Lot #2 to pick up supplies and sign in as a volunteer. Trash bags are provided. Bring water in a reusable container, work gloves, sunscreen, a picker and a hat for protection from the sun. (Activity duration: 4 hours)

FRIDAYS April 11, April 18 and April 25 – 9 a.m. SEMINOLE REST WALK - Explore the nature and history with a park ranger on a walk through the historic site of Seminole Rest. Bring a hat, insect repellent and water. Be prepared to walk up to a half mile on a paved/wood surface. Meet at the Seminole Rest parking lot at 9 a.m. Seminole Rest address: 207 River Rd, Oak Hill, Fla. 32759. (Activity duration: 45 minutes)

MONDAYS April 21 and April 28 – 9 a.m. SEASHORE 101 AT PLAYALINDA - Join a park ranger for a half-hour talk to discover what makes Canaveral National Seashore so special. Meet at Eddy Creek. (Activity duration: 30 minutes)

TUESDAY, April 22 -- “EARTH DAY BEACH CLEAN-UP” – 9 to 10 a.m. Help keep our beaches clean. Join us to clean up your national park during National Park Week. Bring water, sunscreen, bug repellent and a hat. We provide trash bags and keep a record of what you collect. Meet at parking lot #2. (Activity duration: 1 hour)
