Entrance fees apply to all interpretive program participants. All programs meet the requirements for the Canaveral National Seashore Junior Ranger program.

**MONDAYS, May 12 and May 19 at 10 a.m. “SEASHORE 101 AT SEMINOLE REST”**

- Join a park ranger for a 30-minute talk to discover what makes Canaveral National Seashore and Seminole Rest so special. Meet at the main house at 10 a.m. Seminole Rest address: 207 River Road, Oak Hill, Florida. (Activity duration: 30 minutes)

**FRIDAYS, May 16 and May 23 at 9 a.m. - BEACH WALK** - Join a park ranger on a walk through the unique ecosystems of the seashore. Bring a hat, sunscreen, insect repellent and water. Be prepared to walk one mile on the beach. Meet at Parking Lot #2 in Playalinda. We will leave promptly at 9 a.m. (Activity duration: 45 minutes)

**THURSDAY, May 15 - TURTLE WATCH RESERVATIONS** – Reservations will begin for this year’s June Turtle Watch programs. Please visit [Recreation.gov](https://www.recreation.gov) to make reservations. The programs are open to all persons eight (8) years of age and older. Reservations allow a maximum of six (6) persons per reservation. The fee for this program is \$20.00 per person ages 16 and above; and \$1.00 per person for ages 15 and under. Programs will be presented in both Apollo and Playalinda Districts and run from 8 p.m. until midnight on most Friday and Saturday evenings in June. Turtle Watch programs give park visitors a unique opportunity to see a live sea turtle nesting.
