Entrance fees apply to all interpretive program participants. All programs meet the requirements for the Canaveral National Seashore Junior Ranger program.

**MONDAYS, May 12 and May 19 at 10 a.m. "SEASHORE 101 AT SEMINOLE REST"**

- Join a park ranger for a 30-minute talk to discover what makes Canaveral National Seashore and Seminole Rest so special. Meet at the main house at 10 a.m. Seminole Rest address: 207 River Road, Oak Hill, Florida. (Activity duration: 30 minutes)

**FRIDAYS, May 16 and May 23 at 9 a.m. - BEACH WALK** - Join a park ranger on a walk through the unique ecosystems of the seashore. Bring a hat, sunscreen, insect repellent and water. Be prepared to walk one mile on the beach. Meet at Parking Lot #2 in Playalinda. We will leave promptly at 9 a.m. (Activity duration: 45 minutes)

**THURSDAY, May 15 - TURTLE WATCH RESERVATIONS** – Reservations will begin for this year's June Turtle Watch programs. Please visit Recreation.gov to make reservations. The programs are open to all persons eight (8) years of age and older. Reservations allow a maximum of six (6) persons per reservation. The fee for this program is \$20.00 per person ages 16 and above; and \$1.00 per person for ages 15 and under. Programs will be presented in both Apollo and Playalinda Districts and run from 8 p.m. until midnight on most Friday and Saturday evenings in June. Turtle Watch programs give park visitors a unique opportunity to see a live sea turtle nesting.
