FRIDAY 10TH -- “TURTLE TALK” Learn about the 2018 nesting season of the endangered sea turtles of Canaveral National Seashore. Meet at the Visitor Center at 10 AM. (1 hour)

WEDNESDAY 15TH, 22ND AND 29TH-- 9:00 AM - “CANOE MOSQUITO LAGOON”
Reservations will be accepted a week before the canoe date. Join a guide as you explore this rich and diverse estuary up close. Some experience is preferred. You must be at least 8 years old and able to paddle. You must wear covered shoes (no sandals or flip-flops). Bring water, sunscreen and a hat. Dress to get wet. Individuals with their own kayaks or canoes are welcome to join in. Call (386) 428-3384 ext. 0 to reserve your spot. Meet at the Visitors Information Center at 8:45 a.m. We will leave promptly at 9:00 a.m. (2 hours)

FRIDAY 17TH – 10:00 AM – “A STROLL THROUGH TIME” Take a walk back in time to the historic Eldora State House with an experienced volunteer. We’ll tour the house and learn about the history of this once thriving town. Come prepared for a short walk down the old canopy road to the house (insect repellent recommended). Meet at Parking Lot #8. (1 hour)

FRIDAY 31ST – 10:00 AM – “CLAMMING 101” Learn how to collect this delicious bi-valve from the waters of Mosquito Lagoon. Gathering clams has been an activity conducted in this area for thousands of years. Learn tips, techniques and recipes along with the Florida bag and size limits. Salt water fishing license is required. Must wear covered shoes (no sandals or flip-flops). Meet at Parking Lot #1 and cross street to lagoon (note that parking is limited and you should park only in designated parking spots). (1 hour)
