TUESDAYS AND THURSDAYS - 12:00 - 4:00 PM - 5th, 7th, 12th, 14th, 19th, 21st, 26th and 28th - The historic Eldora State House will be open. Tour the displays and learn about the early settlers in this area of Florida. (4 hours)

WEDNESDAY 13th - 10 AM - Learn about the endangered Wilson's Plover and Canaveral's conservation efforts regarding them. Meet at the Visitor Center Auditorium. (1 hour)

THURSDAY 14th and 28th at 10:00 AM - “Canoe Mosquito Lagoon”. Reservations will be accepted a week before the canoe date. Join a guide as you explore this rich and diverse estuary up close. Some experience is preferred. You must be at least 8 years old and able to paddle. You must wear completely enclosed shoes (no sandals or flip-flops). Bring water, sunscreen, and a hat. Dress to get wet. There is a \$25 canoe rental fee. Call (386) 428-3384 ext. 0 to reserve your spot. Meet at the Pavilion behind the Visitor Center. (2 hours)

FRIDAY 22nd - 9 AM - In recognition of this year's Earth Day, please join us in a Lagoon Shoreline Cleanup. Bring your own kayaks/canoes/paddleboards or rent a canoe/kayak from us (\$25/vessel), or walk the shoreline. Please wear sturdy shoes that can get wet, wear sunscreen and a hat and bring plenty of drinking water. Meet at the Visitor Center. (3 hours)
