“JUNE Turtle Watch” -Most Thursday, Friday & Saturday evenings -8:00 PM – Midnight-Journey with a National Park Ranger and visit the undisturbed beaches of Canaveral National Seashore to watch a loggerhead sea turtle nesting. Turtle Watch Programs give park visitors an opportunity to learn about sea turtles and the role that the National Park Service plays in their conservation. The program will take place at Playalinda Beach & Apollo Beach on most Thursdays, Fridays & Saturdays. The fee for this program is \$14.00 per person, ages 16 and above. Ages 15 and under will be free. Children must be 8 years old or older to participate. **Reservation are required and Space is limited.** To make a reservation for June, please call (386) 428-3384 Ext 0.

Wednesday, June 15th “Turtle Watch Reservations Begin for July” - Journey with a National Park Ranger and visit the undisturbed beaches of Canaveral National Seashore to watch a loggerhead sea turtle nesting. Turtle Watch Programs give park visitors an opportunity to learn about sea turtles and the role that the National Park Service plays in their conservation. The program will take place at Playalinda Beach and Apollo Beach on most Thursdays, Fridays & Saturdays. The fee for this program is \$14.00 per person, ages 16 and above. Ages 15 and under will be free. Children must be 8 years old or older to participate. **Reservations are required and Space is limited.
