THURSDAY, 5TH & 17TH – 10:00 AM “BIOLAB NATURE WALK” – Explore the seashore through the view finder. Discover the diversity and beauty of the various plants and animals within the seashore. Bring your camera, water, sunscreen and repellent. Meet at vista 3. (1 hour)

SATURDAY, March 7TH – 9:00 AM “SCRUB JAY VIEWING” – Join a ranger and get a chance to observe this intelligent, rare species. Meet and the Playalinda Beach Ranger Station. (30 minutes)

THURSDAY, March 12TH & 26TH – 10:00 AM “SHORELINE SEASHELL HUNT” – Search for that seashell or sea bean along this pristine undeveloped shoreline. Explore the beach wrack line for treasure. Bring water and sunscreen. Meet at parking area #3, Playalinda Beach. (1 hour)

THURSDAY, March 19TH – 10:00 AM “BARTRAM NATURE WALK” – Walk the historic Bartram Trail hiked by one of the nation’s earliest botanists. Discover the diversity and beauty of the various plants and animals within the seashore. Bring your camera, water, and sunscreen. Meet at the Eddy Creek parking area, Playalinda Beach. (1 hour)

SATURDAY, March 21ST – 6:00 PM to 11:00 PM- “NIGHT SKY EXPLORATION” - Explore the celestial sky with area astronomers. Telescopes will be available for viewing stars, planets and more. Bring bug repellent, water/snacks, and maybe a lawn chair for your comfort. Dress for the weather. Call 321-403-9334 to reserve. **Required reservations begin 1 week in advance** of the event: SPACE IS LIMITED. (Meet at Eddy Creek, Playalinda Beach)

SATURDAY, March 28TH - 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM – “BEACH CLEAN-UP” - Your participation is vital to maintaining a pristine beach habitat. Join us to help keep Playalinda Beach beautiful. Bring water, sunscreen, bug repellent, work gloves and a hat. We provide trash bags. Meet at parking area 1, Playalinda Beach. Sign in and proceed to the parking area of your choice. (1-2 hours)
