**December 1, 7, 13, 15 and 22 from 12 to 4 p.m. -- “DISCOVER SEMINOLE REST”--** Enjoy a brief stroll along the accessible path that leads to the main house located on top of Snyder Mound. Explore the first floor of the late-1800s Gothic Revival-style home located along Mosquito Lagoon in Oak Hill, Florida. Street address for Seminole Rest: 207 River Road., Oak Hill, Fla., 32759. (Activity duration: up to 4 hours)

**MONDAYS, Dec. 1, Dec. 15 and Dec. 22 at 11 a.m. -- SEMINOLE REST GUIDED WALK --** Explore the nature and history with a park ranger on a walk through Seminole Rest. Bring a hat, insect repellent and water. Be prepared to walk up to a half mile on a paved/wood surface. Meet at the Seminole Rest parking lot at 11 a.m. Street address for Seminole Rest: 207 River Road., Oak Hill, Fla., 32759. (Activity duration: 45 minutes)

**TUESDAYS, Dec. 2, Dec. 9 and Dec. 16 at 9 a.m. -- BEACH CLEANUP STROLL --** Join park staff for a guided walk through the unique ecosystems of the seashore while helping to keep our beaches clean. As we explore up to one mile of shoreline, visitors will learn about the coastal environment and assist with light beach cleanup along the way. Trash bags are provided. Please bring a hat, gloves, sunscreen, insect repellent, and water in a reusable container. Meet at Parking Lot #3 in the Playalinda District. (Activity duration: 1 hour)

**FRIDAYS, Dec. 5, Dec. 12 and Dec. 19 at 9 a.m. -- “SEASHORE 101” --** Join park staff for a short talk to discover what makes Canaveral National Seashore so special. Meet at the top of the boardwalk at Parking Lot #3 in the Playalinda District. (Activity duration: 30 minutes)

**SATURDAYS, Dec. 6 and Dec. 20 from 8 to 11 a.m. -- PLAYALINDA BEACH CLEANUP --** Canaveral National Seashore invites the public to join in to help keep our seashore clean. Trash bags are provided. Bring water in a reusable container, work gloves, sunscreen and a hat for protection from the sun. Meet at parking lot #1 in the Playalinda District. (Activity duration: 3 hours)

**Sunday, Dec. 7 and Saturday, Dec. 13 at 2 p.m. -- “SEASHORE GLIMPSE”**- Join park staff for a short talk highlighting the wildlife, history and natural beauty that make Canaveral National Seashore truly special. Meet at the main house. Street address for Seminole Rest: 207 River Road., Oak Hill, Fla., 32759 (Activity duration: 20 minutes)

**Friday, Dec. 12 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. -- “DISCOVER YOUR SEASHORE”** -- Join park staff at the “Discover Your Seashore” table to learn more about what makes Canaveral National Seashore so special. Explore hands-on materials, learn about the park’s wildlife, habitats, history and find out how you can help protect this incredible place. Visitors are welcome to stop by any time during the listed hours. Meet at the top of the boardwalk at Parking Lot #3 in the Playalinda District. (Activity duration: 2 hours)

**Saturday, Dec. 13 at 11 a.m. -- SEMINOLE REST CLEANUP** – Join a park ranger and help keep the park trash free. Bring gloves, water and sunscreen. Meet at the main house. Street address for Seminole Rest: 207 River Road., Oak Hill, Fla., 32759 (Activity duration: 1 hour)

**Saturday, Dec. 20 at 9 a.m. -- GUIDED BEACH WALK** -- Join park staff on a walk through the unique ecosystems of the seashore. Bring a hat, sunscreen, insect repellent and water. Be prepared to walk up to one mile on the beach. Meet at parking lot #3 in the Playalinda District. (Activity duration: 45 minutes)

**Saturday, Dec. 20 at 10 a.m. -- “SHARK TALK”** -- Join park staff for a short presentation on the fascinating world of sharks. Meet at the top of the boardwalk at Parking Lot # 3 in the Playalinda District. (Activity duration: 30 minutes)
