TUESDAYS March 4 and March 18 – 2 p.m. BEACH WALK -- Join a park ranger on a walk through the unique ecosystems of the seashore. Bring a hat, sunscreen, insect repellent and water. Be prepared to walk one mile on the beach. Meet at Playalinda Parking Area #1. We will leave promptly at 2 p.m. (Activity duration: 45 minutes)

Friday, March 7 and Monday, March 17– 11 a.m. SEMINOLE REST WALK -- Explore the nature and history with a park ranger on a walk through the historic site of Seminole Rest. Bring a hat, insect repellent and water. Be prepared to walk up to a half mile on a paved/wooden surface. Meet at the Seminole Rest parking lot at 10 a.m. Seminole Rest address is: 207 River Road, Oak Hill, Fla., 32759. (Activity duration: 45 minutes)

Friday, March 7 and Monday, March 17- 2 p.m. “SEASHORE 101 AT SEMINOLE REST” --Join a park ranger for a 30-minute talk to discover what makes Canaveral National Seashore so special. Meet at the main house at 2 p.m. Seminole Rest address: 207 River Road Oak Hill, Fla., 32759. (Activity duration: 30 minutes)

Monday, March 10 – 2 p.m. “SEASHORE 101 AT PLAYALINDA” -- Join a park ranger for a 30-minute talk to discover what makes Canaveral National Seashore so special. Meet at Eddy Creek at 2 p.m. (Activity duration: 30 minutes)

Saturday, March 22 – 9 to 11 a.m. BEACH CLEANUP - Canaveral National Seashore invites the public to join us to help keep our seashore clean. Trash bags are provided. Bring water in a reusable container, work gloves, sunscreen, and a hat for protection from the sun. Meet at Playalinda Parking Area #1. (Activity duration: 2 hours)

MONDAYS, March 24 and March 31 – 2 p.m. GUIDED NATURE WALK – Explore the seashore and discover the diversity and beauty of the various plants and animals within the park. Bring your camera, water, sunscreen and insect repellent. Meet at the Playalinda Ranger Station. (Activity duration: 45 minutes)
