**TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY, AND FRIDAY JUNE 7TH - 30TH - 10:00 AM TO NOON - “SUMMER JUNIOR ANGLER PROGRAM”** Summer programs are here! Canaveral National Seashore will host an amazing, free, Summer Jr. Angler Program. Youths ages 8-15 will learn the skill of surf (or lagoon) fishing. Along with providing hands-on experience, clinics will include instruction on knot tying, proper tackle, fish identification, and healthy fish habitats. All fishing gear provided. **WEDNESDAY 15<sup>TH</sup> - “TURTLE WATCH RESERVATIONS” - 9:00 AM.**  
Starting Wednesday, we will begin taking reservations for this year's July Turtle Watch programs. The number to call is (386) 428-3384 ext. 248. The programs are open to all persons eight (8) years of age and older. Reservations have a maximum of six (6) persons per reservation call. The fee for this program is \$14.00 per person ages 16 and above; 15 and under are free. Persons with an Access Pass or a Senior Pass receive a 50% discount for the cardholder only. The programs will be presented in both Districts and run from 8:00 PM until midnight on July 2, 7, 8, 9, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 28, 29 and 30. Please have several dates in mind when you call, and we ask that you keep your calls brief. Further information and instructions will be sent to you within two (2) weeks of your phone call. Turtle Watch programs give park visitors a unique opportunity to see a live sea turtle nesting.
