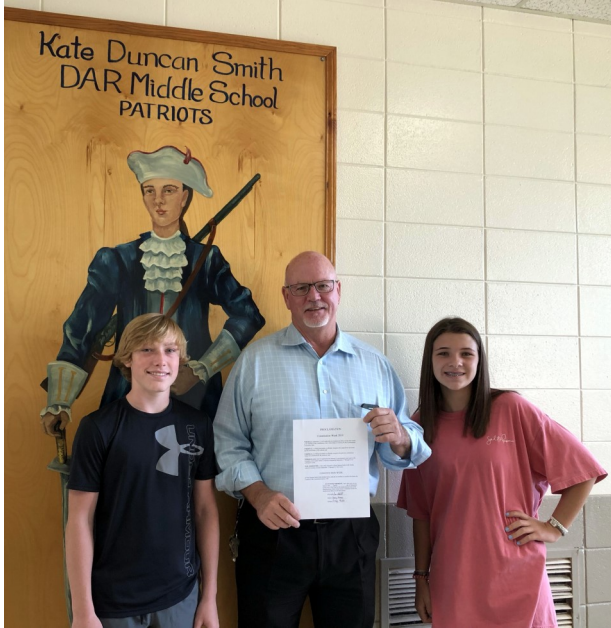


KDS Celebrates Constitution Week
