

KDS Students Participate in Breast Cancer Awareness Month

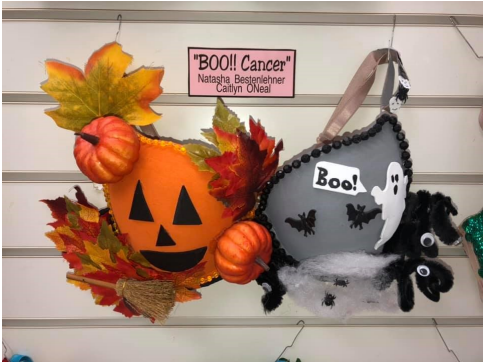


Betsy Montgomery and Brooke Jolly designed the “Don’t Gamble With Your Life” bra, which was chosen as the DAR Members’ Favorite.
