

KDS Students Tour the Niña and the Pinta

KDS students recently toured replicas of two of the three ships used by Christopher Columbus in his 1492 voyage. The Niña and Pinta, which tour together as a new and enhanced 'sailing museum', teach visitors about Columbus' first voyage across the Atlantic. One hundred eighty-two KDS 3rd and 4th graders, as well as 16 students from the Learning Resource Center, traveled to Guntersville to explore the historically accurate replicas moored on the banks of the Tennessee River. Students learned details about the ships themselves as well as living conditions that the original crew members experienced during the Age of Discovery.
