

KDS Elementary Hosts Doughnuts with Dad

KDS Elementary School students and the men in their lives were treated to “Doughnuts with Dad” on an early Friday morning in August. The event, sponsored by the Parent Teacher Organization (PTO), was held in Becker Hall.
