

Indoor Hitting Facility



KDS has recently constructed an indoor hitting and training facility on its campus. The 60' by 100' foot building will be used by the baseball and softball teams for batting practice and other training, particularly during inclement weather.

"With all the rain we've had since the first of the year, it would have been near impossible to practice hitting without this facility. It's a gamechanger," said KDS Varsity Baseball Coach Chris Hicks.

The building is located behind the softball field and has turf flooring and four retractable nets. A small

enclosed area along the back side allows for storage of mowers, field drags and other equipment.

The facility was used recently for a youth baseball skills camp which was a fundraiser for the Varsity baseball team.



The baseball and softball teams alternate practices so that everyone is able to practice batting in the cages.
