In our sin, God still reaches out to forgive and restore us.


Having confessed our sins, rejoice in the assurance of God's love.

Scripture Reading: 2 Corinthians 9:6-15


A reading from the 9th chapter of 2 Corinithians.





*Prayer after Communion


