The Mayfield Heights Police Department is scheduled for a virtual assessment and public hearing as part of a program to achieve Law Enforcement Accreditation by verifying our agency meets professional standards.

The Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA) administers the Law Enforcement Accreditation Program. The accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

As part of the virtual assessment, employees of the Police Department, members of the community and law enforcement agencies are invited to offer comments "in-person" through live video conferencing on Monday, December 14, 2020, beginning at 5:00 p.m. The session will be conducted at the City of Mayfield Heights City Hall, located at 6154 Mayfield Road, Mayfield Heights, Ohio 44124. CDC guidelines shall be followed.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by calling (440) 442-2626, Ext. 203 on Monday, December 14, 2020 between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. The Assessment Team will take comments.
