

Annual High School Scholarship Award

The members of the Pleasanton Police Officers' Charitable Foundation will recognize graduating seniors by presenting each with a financial award to assist with educational expense at the college of their choice.

Award Amount: We will award three (3) individual students with a Five Hundred Dollar (\$500) Scholarship. We will award selected students from the three high schools to assist them with their college expenses. These funds will be deposited into an account at the respective school attended by each of the winners.

Requirements: All applicants must be attending Amador, Foothill, Village, or Horizon High Schools and be in good standing. Students must have a grade point average of 2.5 or better, and be a graduating senior.

Essay: Applicants must submit the following to be considered.

- 1) Resume
- 2) An autobiography (in at least 500 words) to reflect your personality, aspirations, and any additional information you deem relevant to the scholarship committee, including school/community activities you have participated in the past that made a significant impact in your life.
- 3) Selecting one of the two essay topics below;
 - a. "The significance of a positive relationship between our community's youth and the police."
 - b. "From a student's prospective, what are two critical issues facing law enforcement officers today and how can they be addressed?"

Selection Process: The Pleasanton Police Officers' Charitable Foundation will screen all applications and make final selection of awards based on community service, involvement, and content of the essay.

Obligations: In the event a recipient does not enroll in an accredited institution by the fall term of the school year in which the scholarship was awarded, the prize will be forfeited and, when possible, be awarded to an alternate recipient.

Filing Date: All applications, resumes, and essays need to be submitted by April 15th, 2019 at 1700 hrs. Applications must be dropped off at the SRO office at Foothill HS, SRO office at Amador Valley HS or the Village HS front office. You must meet this filing date to be considered!
