SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR APPLICANTS

- 1. California School Employees Association Chapter 155 (Pleasanton, CA) is prepared to offer scholarships to graduating seniors who have been accepted at accredited colleges, universities, or post high school training institution.
- 2. The screening committee, based on the funds available, will determine the maximum amount given any one student.
- 3. Our funds enable us to award one or more scholarships to candidates who meet the following criteria:
 - Parent must be employed by the Pleasanton Unified School District and be a member in good standing with the California Schools Employee Association, Chapter 155.
 - Applicant must be a graduating high school senior accepted at an accredited college, university, or post high school training. Applicant must be a full time student carrying a minimum of 12 units and be in good standing with the institution.
 - Applicant has achieved a positive activity record in school and/or community. The student does not need to be active in a large number of extra curricular activities. The committee is looking for evidence that the student recognizes his/her responsibility to make a contribution to the community (school or residential) of which he/she is a part and that he/she is able to meet the responsibility successfully.
 - Applicant has formulated a well-defined plan for the future. Students do not have to make a firm decision on a specific choice of vocation. However, they should have definite plans for post high school continuing education and have considered alternate choices of subject areas in which they may specialize. The committee is always interested in the reason a student has for their choice of institution and the conscientiousness with which he/she has pursued gaining admittance to the institution of his/her choice.
 - Student has a strong school recommendation.
 The screening committee expects that the school endorse each of its candidates as being fully capable of following through successfully on the post high school plan he/she has outlined.
- 4. For each candidate submitted, the school/college/training institution is asked to send the following:
 - ✓ Scholarship application form
 - ✓ Official Transcript of School Record
 - ✓ One written recommendation from counselor or teacher in field of major interest
 - ✓ Written description of career goals
 - ✓ Other pertinent material the school may wish to include
