

ARE YOU THINKING ABOUT APPLYING FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDING?

NOW is the time to start exploring the possibility of obtaining future Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding to help your community.

CDBG funding is granted to qualified infrastructure or public facility improvement projects that are located in designated low- to –moderate-income (LMI) census tract/block group areas. Funding is also granted for qualified economic development or public service projects that directly benefit eligible LMI persons/families in your community.

If you believe you have a project that could qualify for CDBG funding, please contact the Stark County CDBG Department. Staff is available to answer questions or to meet with your municipality/township/non-profit agency to discuss potential project ideas.

Examples of potential projects include:



Infrastructure improvements such as water and sewer lines



Public services that benefit low-income populations



Public facility improvements that serve at-risk populations



Economic development to assist underserved individuals
